"The Aztec Pantheon and the Art of Empire"

Organized to celebrate the bicentennial of Mexican independence, this exhibition explores Europe's first interpretation of the Aztecs. In the 16th century, Europeans viewed their first encounters with Mexican cultures through the lens of classical history, drawing analogies between the Aztec and the Roman empires. Masterworks of Aztec sculpture—largely from the collections of the National Museum of Anthropology and recent excavations at *Templo Mayor* in Mexico City—are the point of departure for considering Old World myths with New World realities.

The exhibition will run March 25 to July 5, 2010, at the Getty Villa Malibu.
